

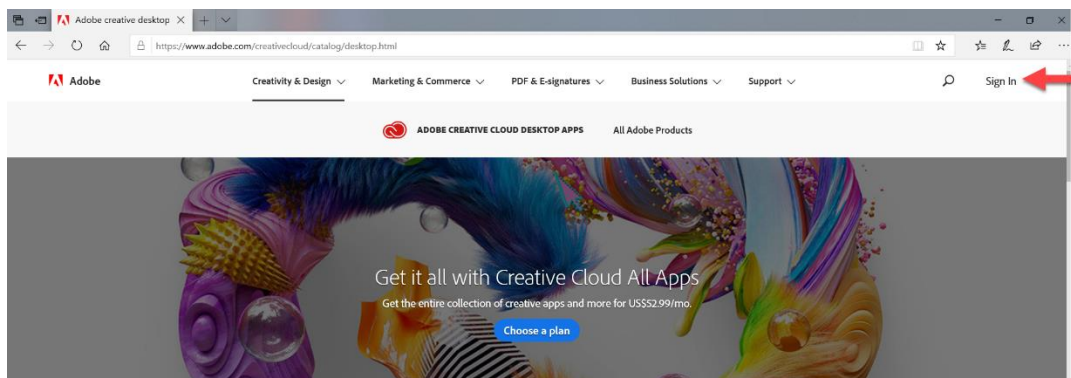
Process to install the Adobe Cloud at Home

Disclaimer: If your machine does not have the proper hardware it may not be able to handle running the 2019 or 2020 version of the Adobe Cloud Software. Keep that in mind as you go to install the program at home.

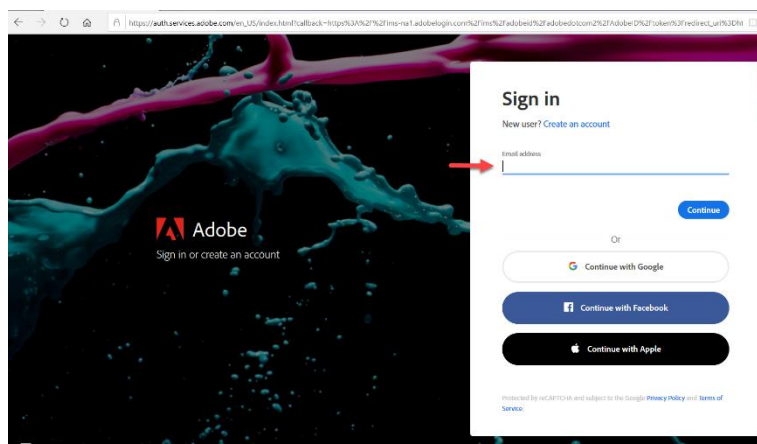

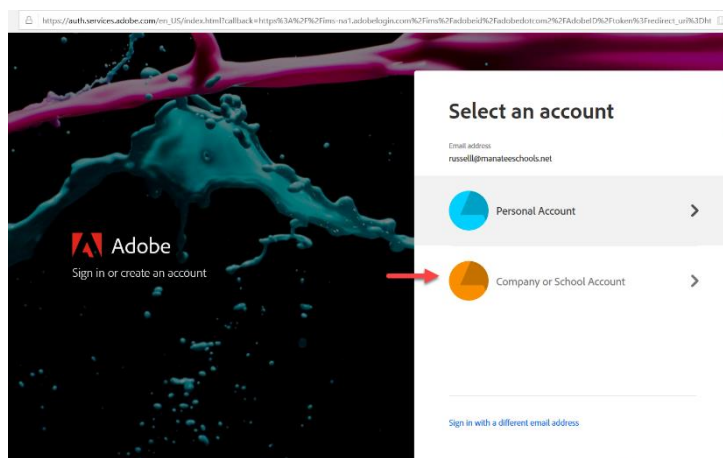
- 1. Click the following link to login and download the Adobe Cloud Desktop App.**
- 2. <https://creativecloud.adobe.com/apps/all/desktop/pdp/creative-cloud>**
- 3. Choose “Sign In” on the window displayed:**



4. You will be prompted to login to Adobe with your school email address:



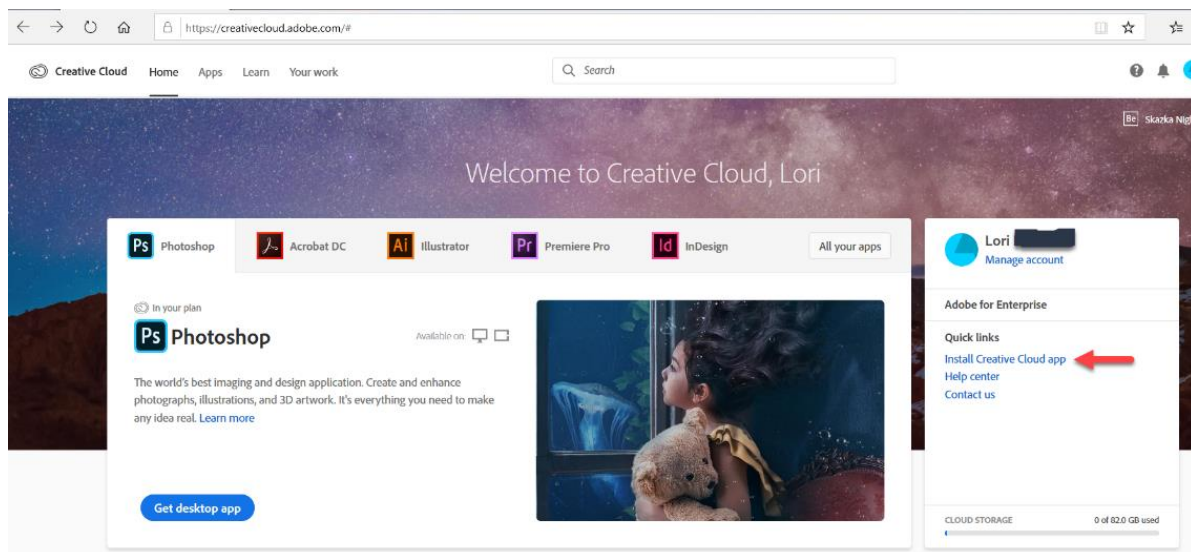
5. Choose "Work or School Account":



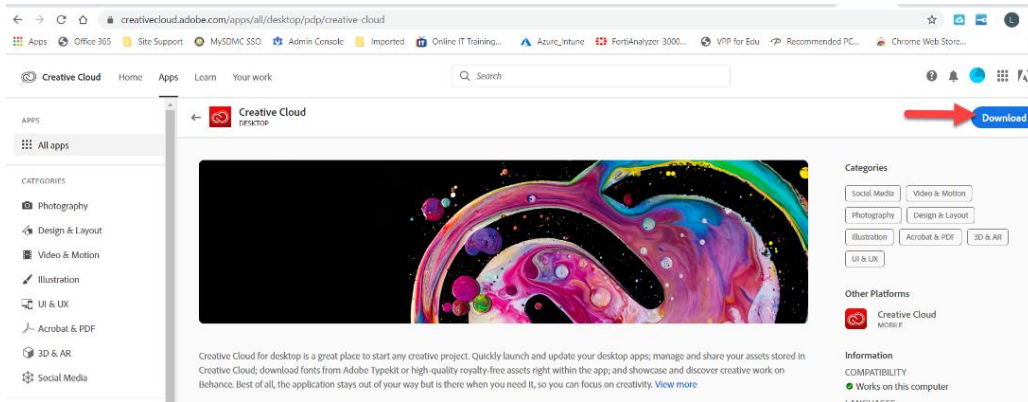
6. Enter your school credentials (district email address and password) at the prompt:



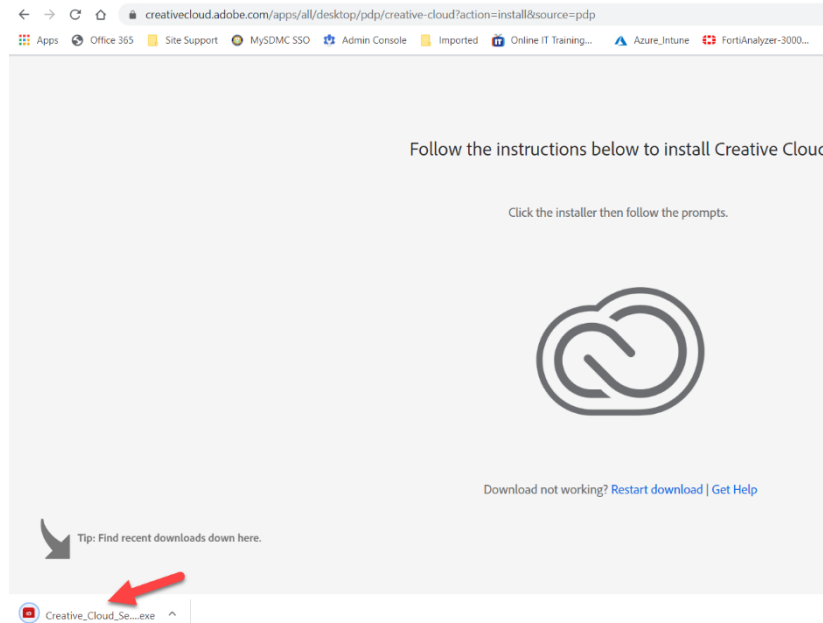
7. On the Adobe window displayed, choose "Install Creative Cloud app":



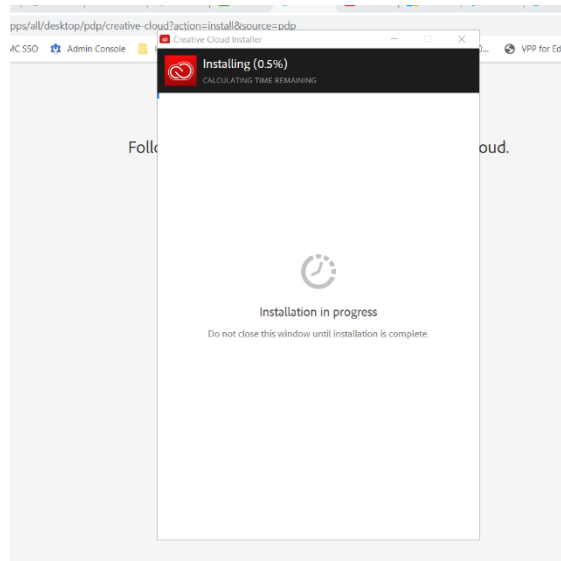
8. Choose “Download” :



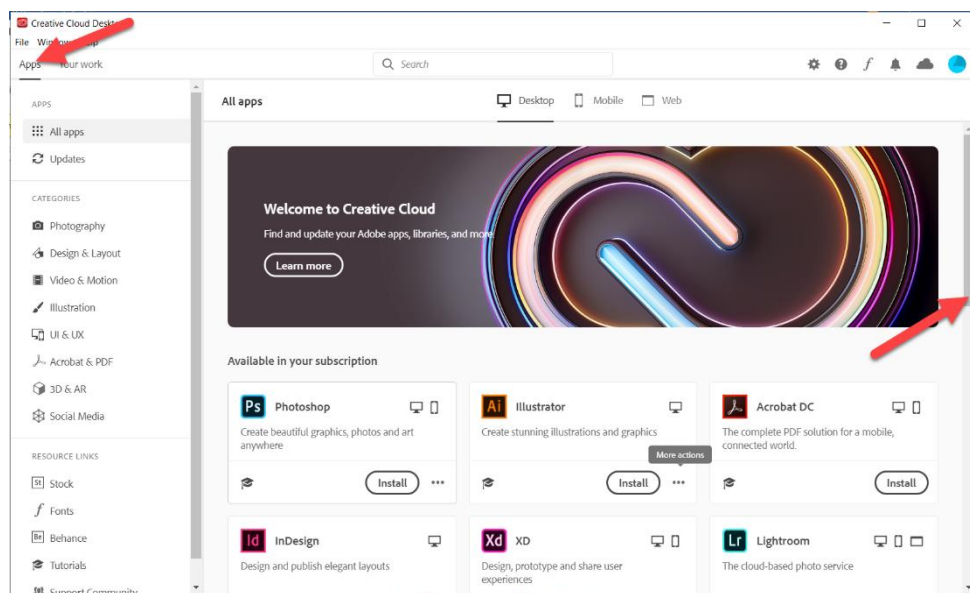
9. Locate the installer that you downloaded in the previous step (it may show in the bottom of your browser window) and will also be located in the “downloads” folder on the computer:



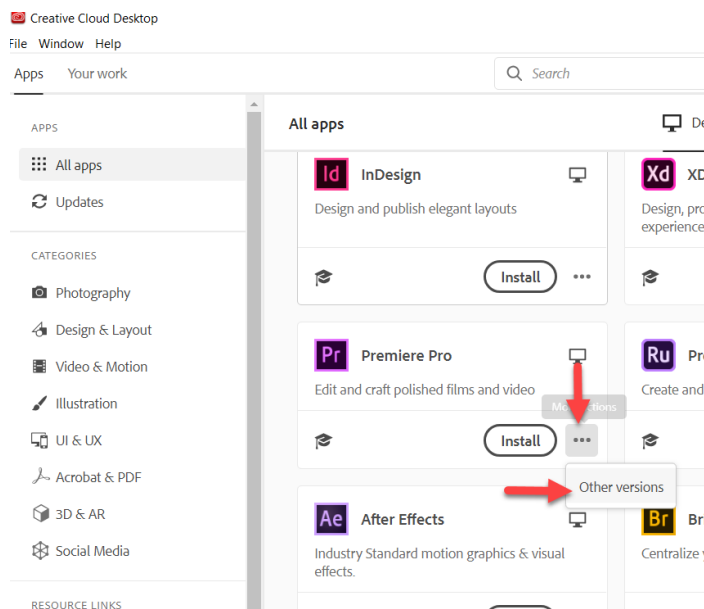
10. The desktop app install progress window will be displayed:



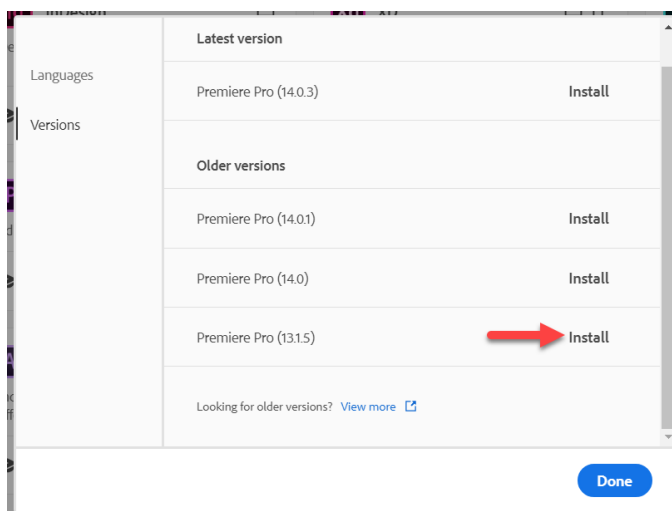
11. Once the Adobe Desktop app is installed you will see the Adobe Desktop landing page. Be sure the "Apps" tab is selected. To see additional applications available for install, use the scroll bar to scroll down to the application that you would like to install:



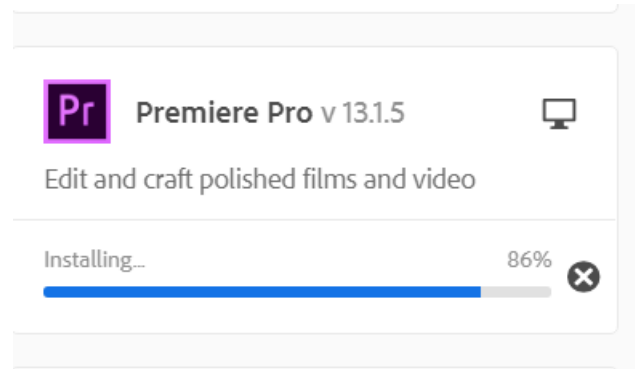
- 12. Click on the three dots next to the “Install” button. In the “drop down” menu, select “Other Versions” to install CC 2019. (If you choose the main install button here, the latest version of the application will be installed which is currently 2020)**



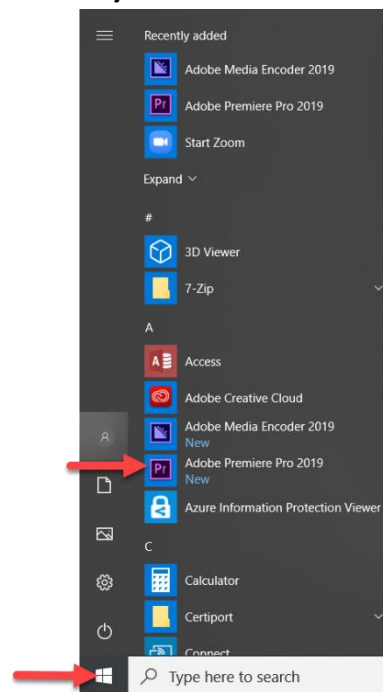
- 13. Select the desired version and choose “Install”. Older versions are required for Certiport Compass testing. Adobe no longer provides the option to download the 2018 version of Adobe CC, the oldest version that is available is CC 2019.**



14. The progress window for the application that you are installing will be displayed:



15. Once the progress window closes, your application is installed and ready to use. To avoid inadvertently updating the version of your application, access the application from the windows app list (windows start button):



16. You may download additional applications as needed following the same process of steps 11 through 15 above.
