












Wild for Warhol

1. Open Image
2. Make sure background & foreground colors are set to default (black & white) 
3. Select and cut background (background should be white) 
4. Make 2 copies of the background layer
5. Hide the top 2 layers 
6. Cover background layer with a gradient fill 
7. **SAVE**
8. Show the middle layer 
9. Apply CUTOUT filter
10. Use magic wand to remove white background 
11. Make sure background & foreground are set to default (black & white) 
12. Show the top layer 
13. Apply the STAMP filter
14. Use the magic wand to select & delete all the white 
15. **SAVE**
16. Flatten the layers
17. Make 4 copies of the merged layer
18. Resize the canvas 200% width & height
19. Zoom to fit screen 
20. Move each layer to a corner 
21. Adjust color hue and saturation for each layer
22. **SAVE**
